



The Launch Programme was introduced to Coventry University by CU Social Enterprise CIC in 2019 to support students, staff and alumni in solving the world's problems as described in the UNSDGs through viable business solutions.

Improving access to continued education and employment through the Enhancing Futures Programme



The Enhancing Futures workshops delivered by CUSE representatives attracted a high number of registrations, exceeding the initial assigned student capacity. Sessions delivered online had an interactive approach and covered a wide range of entrepreneurial topics from how to develop an entrepreneurial mindset, to support given in creating a business plan and preparing for a pitch session, or more insights on what it is and how to launch a Social Enterprise.

We received great feedback and had 10 new students who registered for the entrepreneurial training programme Evolve and the Launch network has expanded, students joining the LinkedIn group with 46 new connections since the sessions have started and started to follow us on Social Media channels.

Abdallah was a graduate who had just obtained an MBA at Coventry University.

Having trained as an architectural engineer at the University of Jordan, then later at the Global Village for Future Leaders of Business and Industry at Lehigh University, Abdallah had then successfully run two start-ups in his native Jordan.

For his UK-based venture, Abdallah presented Rescue House, an innovative temporary housing solution designed for the homeless and people displaced by war and natural disasters.

Abdallah was given one-to-one training and support to prepare his business plan and pitch to the standard expected at the Start Up Visa assessment panel.

The judges were extremely impressed with his concept and passion to change lives.

Since being endorsed, Abdallah won a place on the Antler 2021 start up accelerator, which is a global early-stage investment platform.

Abdallah is a true entrepreneur, and we are proud to offer him support on the Emerge Start Up Visa programme.

CASE STUDY ANDRE*



Having been granted asylum in the UK, Andre was facing the substantial barrier of job-search in English, which is not his first language. Andre's long-term ambition was to build a social enterprise and improve lives by inspiring others through his love of music and the arts. New business start-up support was provided on a one-to-one basis, including sessions on legal structure, marketing and networking, finance, and pitching for grant funding. In addition to this, Andre was supported with CV building workshop, English language coaching in the context of business, basic IT skills to aid job-search and applications, and assistance with understanding formal correspondence from government, e.g., benefits and housing communications.

As a result of the support received on Connect2, Andre has now registered a new social enterprise on Companies House. In line with his longer-term ambition, he now organises and performs at cultural music festivals. Andre aims to make this a social enterprise to benefit and support other immigrants to the UK.
